Updates

Early Childhood Education Regulatory Review

For information

The Early Childhood Education Sector Regulatory Review continues to analyse and test initial findings and recommendations.

To date, we have held 15 testing workshops covering regulatory monitoring, regulatory capability and performance, licencing criteria (multiple workshops), regulatory tools, curriculum, qualifications and ratios, regulatory strategy, approach, culture and leadership.

Initial findings from testing workshops were provided to the ECE Regulatory Review Steering Group (the Steering Group) on the 21 of October as part of the cross-agency consultation process. We are considering feedback from the Steering Group members on these findings. We will be presenting initial recommendations to the Steering Group on 5 November.

Our next briefing will be delivered on 14 November and will share initial findings and recommendations, including an update on the second tranche of licensing criteria. Work on the report is progressing well, we will present you with a final draft report for your consideration on 13 December.

The Agricultural and Horticultural Review team (Review team) further discussed and tested options

On Tuesday 29 October and Wednesday 30 October the Review team also met with the Office of the Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment, and AgrizeroNZ to understand environmental and research and development views on the options we have developed. Both groups provided useful feedback which we will consider in our development of recommendations. We also met with Fonterra and Zespri on Thursday 31 October to discuss their feedback on options.

This week, we provided joint ministers with a briefing updating on the progress of the review and providing our preliminary findings. This briefing was tested with agencies and the Senior Officials Advisory Group. We will shortly begin testing draft recommendations with broader agencies, including the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, and Treasury, ahead of providing draft recommendations for the joint ministers meeting in late November.
